# FAR WESTERN REGIONAL CONFERENCE AWARDS INFORMATION

## Eligibility Requirements

(Note: “Current year” refers to the year of the conference)

Chapter Awards – Only active chapters who have filed **PROGRAM REPORTS ONLINE BY DEC 31ST**, and the Annual Chapter Reports and Standards (Chapter Evaluation) on file in the corporate office, Regional Director’s office, and the appropriate National Committee Chairman, by **December 31, 2011** will be eligible to participate in the competition.

An official Undergraduate Grade Report, which includes the immediate past Fall/Winter cumulative grade point average of members in the chapter, must be filed with the Regional Director by **January 31, 2012**.

A current list of officers with addresses and phone numbers (undergraduate list should include the home phone numbers and e-mail addresses) should be on file with the Regional Director by **January 31, 2012**.

Chapters that have been under any type of penalty by the sorority or college (undergraduate) since the Regional Conference must obtain permission from the Regional Director to compete for Regional Awards

The soror who submits an **INDIVIDUAL AWARD** entry must not have been under any type penalty by the sorority or the college (undergraduate) since the last Regional Conference.

Any outstanding Boule / Hospitality / Luncheon and Regional Awards fees must be paid by **March 15, 2012**. The current year's assessments must be paid by **March 15, 2012** also.

Host Cluster chapters may compete for **INDIVIDUAL AWARDS, EXHIBITS and/or CHAPTER AWARDS**

Awards are not to exceed ten pages. Pages should be uncluttered and typed on only one side. The Archalene Amos Martin Creative Arts and Performing Arts Award is an exception to this rule. This award should not exceed three (3) typewritten pages, with pictures included.

## **Criteria for Judging**

Materials will be judged on the basis of:

1. Subject matter
2. Creativity
3. Adherence to timeline
4. Adherence to guidelines
5. Neatness
6. Presentation
7. Exceeds minimum criteria

## **Format/Size**

- A bound 8 1/2" x 11" folder should be utilized for submitting the materials.
- Each award must be presented separately.

## **The Archalene Amos Martin Creative and Performing Arts Award**

Given to recognize outstanding achievement and contributions by an undergraduate and a graduate member in the field of the creative and performing arts through contributions to the Far Western Region, her chapter, and her community. The member must be financial, nominated and endorsed by her chapter. The letter of endorsement must not exceed one page. The evidence and documentation, including pictures must not exceed three (3) typewritten or computer pages. Soror Archalene Amos-Martin, 17th Far Western Regional Director shall provide input to the Awards Committee after perusal of all applications submitted.

## **The E. Lavonne Lewis Tutorial Service Award**

The program must demonstrate a unique, creative and innovative approach to assisting children and must include an economic component after 2006.

### **Required documentation**

- Sign-in logs with length of sessions
- Pictures of tutorial sessions
- Documentation from the school where tutoring takes place

# ALPHA KAPPA ALPHA AWARD FOR MEDIA EXCELLENCE

The Alpha Kappa Alpha Award for Media Excellence is presented to a Graduate and Undergraduate chapter that distinguishes itself in each region for expanding the ALPHA KAPPA ALPHA presence through execution of a strategic media plan as well as for exemplary media coverage of their programs of service and community activities on a local, regional and international basis. A full range of communication assets should be utilized including sorority publications, external media outlets such as radio, television, print, and digital media and social media outlets.

The award will be presented at each 2012 regional conference for the first place finishers in the Undergraduate and Graduate categories. The regional winners will go on to be judged for the national honor at the Boule. One Graduate and Undergraduate chapter will be presented the first-place award with the national second place and third place chapters also receiving awards.

Submissions will be judged by the International Communications Committee member designated to do the judging for our region. Mailing expenses to the Communications Committee member will be absorbed by the competing chapters. All of the submissions will be displayed at the Regional Conference but only the winning submission will be kept by the Communications Committee representative for final judging at the Boule.

The evidence and documentation, including pictures must not exceed three (3) typewritten or computer pages. Soror Archalene Amos-Martin, 17th Far Western Regional Director shall provide input to the Awards Committee after perusal of all applications submitted.

## **The Diana G. Shipley “Golden Soror” Award**

Given to recognize the achievement of the Golden Soror in your chapter. Consideration is based on leadership, support of chapter activities and implementation of goals of the Sorority. Each category must be validated with supporting documents. A soror must be nominated by her chapter and only one chapter nominee per year. Only one award will be given at the Regional Conference.

**Soror must be present to accept the award.**

## **E. Lavonne Lewis Tutorial Service Award**

This award is presented to a graduate and undergraduate chapter that operates a tutorial program for at least four months that provides services to enhance the educational achievement of a group of seven or more students from grades 3 through 12. The program must demonstrate a unique, creative and innovative approach to assisting children and must include an economic component after 2006.

**Required documentation**

- Sign-in logs with length of sessions
- Pictures of tutorial sessions
- Documentation from the school where tutoring takes place

**LaVern S. Tarkington Leadership Development Award**

A chapter who has established an exemplary leadership development program or an individual soror who has demonstrated exemplary mentorship for leadership development of others is eligible for this award. A description of the chapter’s program or an individual’s efforts to mentor future leaders will be evaluated using the award criteria. Future leaders include undergraduate members, youth in the community or graduate members identified for leadership positions. Chapter or individual should demonstrate long term (greater than 1 year) sustainability of leadership development program and the ability to gain participation of others (i.e. mentees, chapter sorors, volunteers, etc.) in the program or leadership development activities.
